

Introducing Recruiter System Connect


LinkedIn Recruiter System Connect (RSC) integrates LinkedIn Recruiter with your Mercury account to make your hiring process even simpler. By turning on RSC, you're authorizing the sharing of some candidate, job and application data across Recruiter and Mercury. It enables you to get up-to-date candidate information, boost collaboration, and access more applicant data in Recruiter. See how to easily connect your two accounts on the next few pages.

Please note: Recruiter System Connect is only compatible with LinkedIn Recruiter Corporate or LinkedIn Professional Services.




Sign in to your Mercury account. Under the **Dynamics 365** dropdown menu, select **Mercury LinkedIn**.




If you then navigate to **Onboarding** and then select **Sign in**, a pop-up window will appear asking you to enter your credentials. Once entered, click **Sign in**.



Select the [LinkedIn](#) contract you wish to link with Mercury.



Once you have selected the contract, you will be shown the relevant options that you are able to select.



Once you have saved your choices, you will then be taken to LinkedIn Recruiter System Connect.

Enter your LinkedIn credentials and select your Recruiter contract. Once signed in, click your profile image on the right, then select **Admin Settings** from the drop-down menu.

From your Admin Settings page, click **ATS** on the left. Locate Mercury and select **Edit** to enable **Contract Level Access** or **Company Level Access** as needed, by selecting **On**.

For details on what each feature level access means, please click **Learn More**. The status under the ATS tab in Recruiter Admin Settings will display **Activated** when either Contract Level Access, Company Level Access, or both access levels appear as on.

Note: If you have multiple Recruiter dashboards, each admin must sign in and enable contract-level access from their specific dashboard.

Once you've enabled both Company Level and Contract Level access toggles, you can close the LinkedIn Recruiter tab and navigate back to Mercury where the status under RSC will now read **Enabled**.

To the right of the **Request an Integration** module, click the button to **Start your historical data transfer**.

The process of syncing your data will start and indicate the status for each of the data sets that are being synced. Once complete, all data sets will appear as green.
